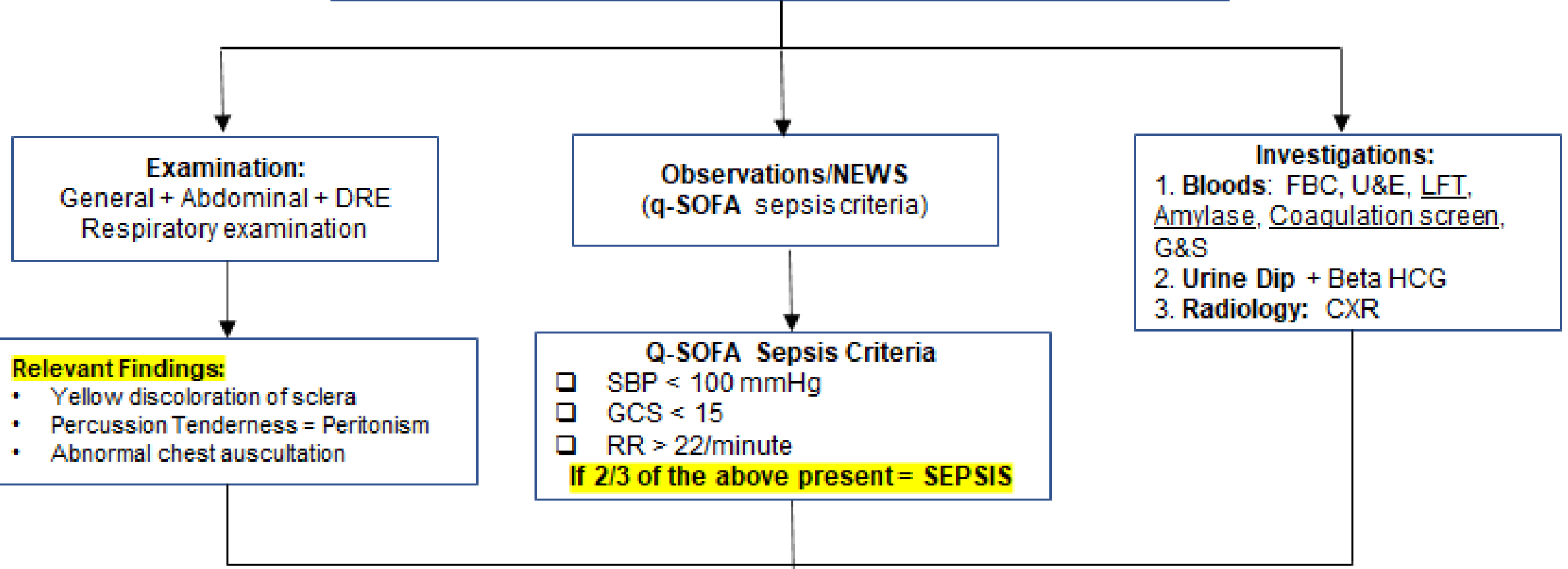


**RUQ pain +/-**

1. Nausea/Vomiting – Think **Biliary colic/Acute calculous cholecystitis**
2. Jaundice + Fever – Think **Ascending cholangitis**
3. Respiratory symptoms – Think **Pneumonia**
4. Red flag signs + Jaundice – Think **malignancy**



**Peritonism + Sepsis + Deranged inflammatory/liver markers**

**YES - Urgent senior advice**

1. NBM + Strict Input/output charting
2. IV Fluids (see NICE guidelines)
3. Regular Paracetamol + Opiate and PRN Morphine + Antiemetic
4. IV Antibiotics if septic/ deranged inflammatory markers\*
5. Stop Anticoagulants if bleeding/Abnormal Coag
6. Follow AKI bundle if AKI\*\*

**NO - Review on ward round**

1. Orally Sips only
2. AKI - IV fluids + medication review
3. Regular Paracetamol + Opiate and PRN Morphine + Antiemetic
4. Abdominal USS (if not done in last 1 year)

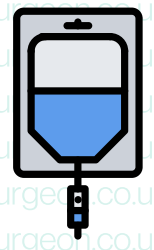
